Introduction:

MTG plans to put one computer into every classroom – question arises: aren't other things (new board, curtains, painted walls etc.) more important? In my opinion importance of c. in school overestimated.

Main part:

First of all succesful teaching and learning is based on human communication.

- only a human can e.g. paraphrase tasks and/or explanations so that students understand
- computer programs may be very patient but they cannot respond individually

Secondly putting one computer into every classroom is simply ridiculous.

- What is teacher supposed to do one PC for ca. 30 students?
- useless without projector (not: beamer) (but far too expensive)
- if computer can't be locked away it will be broken soon

Finally school should promote speaking skills.

- especially in language lessons sitting in front of a PC means being silent
- in today's big classes much more important that students have as much speaking time as possible

- students sit long enough alone and silent in front of their PC and TV at home, school should not

reinforce that "autistic" behaviour

Final paragraph:

- All in all computers useful tool to enrich lessons, but two well-equipped computer rooms are enough
- far too expensive to put one PC (with projector) into each classroom
- more important: new OHPs and/or boards, current textbooks, better/friendlier library
